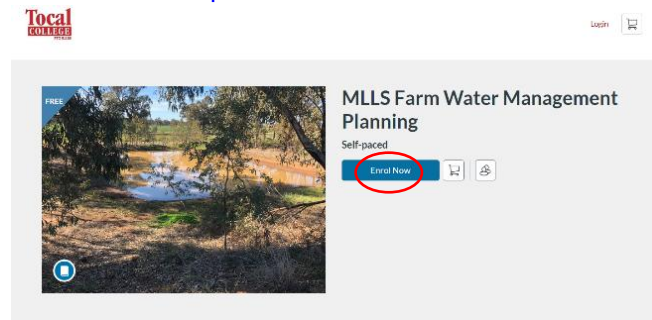


ACCESSING TO THE Tocal LEARNING MODULES

Follow these steps to access the Tocal Learning Module on Sustainable Farm Dams:

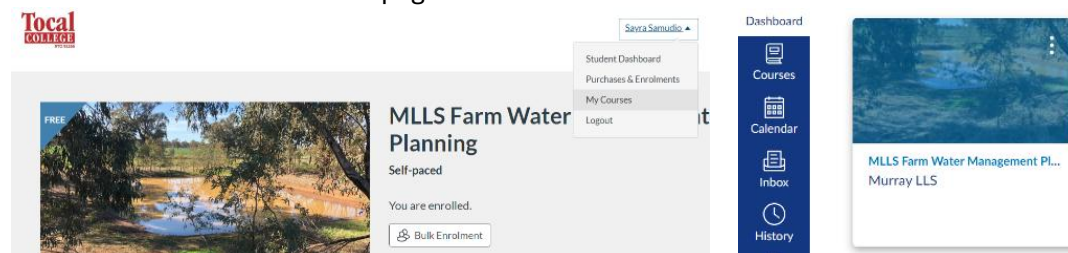

These learning modules, in particular the Farm Dams one, is designed to introduce you to some of the concepts and components of the Farm Water Management Planning that you have nominated to undertake. Through your regional producer group, you will hopefully take the steps needed to develop this plan to help your farm business be better prepared for dry seasons or droughts and be able to come through those periods less impacted. The Workshop you will attend will drill down in more detail to cover topics such as a Farm Water Budget/ Audit, that will determine farm water supplies and demands, drought strategy, and what options journey time to improve your water security.

2. **If you already have a Tocal account**, log in with your details and proceed to the checkout page to confirm your enrolment.
3. Click on "My Courses" after confirming your enrolment. This will show your ongoing courses. Click "begin course" to access the Modules page.



4. Look for "Water Management – compulsory" at the top. Complete the modules listed under this section to finish the course.
The "Sustainable Farm Dams module" is the only compulsory module. Other modules below it are optional but provide valuable information like drought resilience and NRM.
5. **If you don't have a Tocal account**, enter your full name and email for enrolment verification.
6. Follow the instructions in the verification email and click "verify" to access your Catalog dashboard.
7. Proceed to "Go to Courses" and click "begin course" to access the Modules page.
8. Follow step 4 or 5 above.

Completing the Sustainable Farm Dams Module is required and doing so before the Workshop will enhance your overall experience during the event.
