Water NSW Maximum Harvestable Right's Calculator

Tips: Know your land holding size (acres or hectares) and be able to put a pin on the online map (you might like to enter your decimal GPS point if you have it).

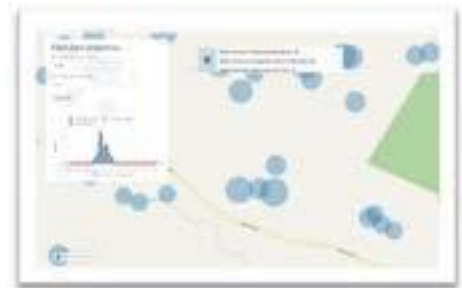


AUS Dams Interactive Map

Tips: An interesting tool to look at but shouldn't be taken as accurate.

This does not replace ground truthing your own property and water storages.



Six Maps (NSW Government Spatial Services)

Tips: Can search for properties based on Address and Lot and DP numbers. Can be used to calculate surface areas of dams. Google Earth is also a good tool with similar capabilities but cannot search by Lot & DP.



Australian Ground Water Explorer

Tips: Initially is a lot to look at. This allows you to navigate around the region and click on bores local to your area and check features such as depth of bore holes.
